

Virginia Poultry Litter Transport Incentive Program



The Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Virginia Poultry Federation are offering a poultry litter transport incentive program to facilitate the efficient use of poultry litter as a crop nutrient source in areas that can most benefit from those nutrients. The goal is to encourage the development of self-sustaining poultry litter markets in areas outside of the main poultry producing counties.



Incentive Payments

\$12 per ton of litter for the counties of Bedford, Bland, Buchanan, Campbell, Carroll, Dickenson, Floyd, Franklin, Giles, Grayson, Halifax, Henry, Lee, Montgomery, Patrick, Pittsylvania, Pulaski, Roanoke, Russell, Scott, Smyth, Tazewell, Washington, Wise, Wythe.

\$5 per ton of litter for other counties except as noted in Program Requirements.

Key Program Requirements:

- Poultry litter must originate from Rockingham or Page counties
- End-user must have, and follow, a current Nutrient Management Plan for fields receiving litter
- Fields receiving litter must have soil phosphorus level of M + or lower
- End-user must provide safe off-loading and proper storage sites as identified in NMP
- The counties of Accomack, Augusta, Northampton, Page, Rockingham and Shenandoah are **not** eligible destinations for litter in this program
