



The Controller is responsible for all financial and fiscal management aspects of company operations, and has primary day-to-day responsibility for planning, implementing, managing and controlling all financial-related activities. This includes direct responsibility for Accounting, Treasury, Shareholder Relations and PAC. The incumbent is responsible for all financial reporting within and outside the company, including reporting monthly financial results to the Board of Directors.
