POSITION SUMMARY

The Veterinarian is responsible for the health and well-being of turkey flocks to produce wholesome products efficiently and safely by conducting all necessary veterinary procedures.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Perform all necessary veterinary care and procedures for commercial turkeys grown in the assigned live operation region to insure their care, health and well-being
- Provide and document surveillance, clinical diagnostics and treatment regimens for flocks
- Act as a primary liaison with industry colleagues, customers, and regulatory agencies as needed
- Provide guidance to Live Operations and management to ensure efficient production of healthy birds for processing
- Promote and support the Animal Care and Well-Being and Biosecurity programs by providing training and conducting audits for program effectiveness and results
- Assist in research projects and other duties as assigned.
